

**Pg. 26:** Hiker Hut: please use phone number 207-897-8984

**\*Pg. 26:** Farmhouse Inn 207-864-3113 of Rangeley has a hiker bunkroom for \$30PP, includes shower w/towel and return to the trailhead on Route 4. Nice clean facility with use of a kitchen; about one-half mile south of IGA (2057 Main St.).

**\*Pg. 35:** Above the Notch Motor Inn has closed.

**Pg. 42:** Glenclyff PO hours are M-F noon-2pm, 7am-1pm Sat.

**\*Pg. 49:** On the Edge Farm is open Saturdays in summer. Hours: M-Sa 10-5:30, Sun 10-5.

**Pg. 49:** West Hartford Village Store has closed.

**Pg. 52:** Sobo mi. 494.6: Killington Lodge will open on Killington Peak May-Jun 10am-3pm, June 28-Sept 1 10am-5pm. There's food service but no "lodging" on the peak. Gondola ride (\$15 round trip) to the ski resort.

**Pg. 53:** Whistle Stop has reopened, new number is 802-0772-7012. Open M, Tu 7-3, Th-Sa 7-7, Su 8-3, closed Wednesday. Has meals and WiFi now, plans to later add ice cream, beer, and charging stations.

**Pg. 57, sobo mi. 551.8:** Stratton Mountain Resort 802-297-400 can be reached by taking a 1.0 mi. side trail from the summit to a gondola ride. Gondola has limited hours and will only be open June 20-22, July 4-6, and then closed until Labor Day. Even when running, hours are limited, so don't make the walk unless you are certain of gondola operation (or are willing to walk an additional 1.5 miles down ski slopes). The resort has a restaurant, hotel rooms starting at \$84 in summer, and First Run Ski Shop (802-297-2200) that has footwear, fuel and snacks.

**Pg. 68:** AT Bicycle Works & Outfitter in Cheshire has closed. Remaining inventory of canister fuel may be available; ask at St. Marys.

**Pg. 69:** All Points Driving Service 413-429-7397 based in Great Barrington, shuttles ranging from Dalton to Salisbury.
